After the conference, INPPA awards to the participants professional training points according to the criteria provided by the Methodology, based on evidence, delivered by each participant.

EVENING EVENTS AND VENUES

Wednesday, 18 June 2025 - Welcome Reception with Buffet Dinner at KOSMOS (19.30 - 23.00)

KOSMOS was opened in 1961 as a prestige project of the German Democratic Republic (GDR), as the most modern film theatre in the country. In a time when the whole world stood wide-eyed to see who would conquer space, the architects *Josef Kaiser, Herbert Aust* and *Guenter Kunert* went with the spirit of the times and let their creation be shaped by the space race – even the inside lights are built to appear as the jets of a space rocket. With 1001 seats, KOSMOS was the largest and most popular film theatre in the GDR, where several DEFA ilms had their premieres.

The 1990 Berlin Film Festival was marked by the fall of the Wall and KOSMOS in East Berlin was one of the festival cinemas. Guests from Hollywood celebrated the start of this Berlinale here, which showed their films in the GDR for the first time. Preserving the original architectural style of the building was a top priority during its extensive modernisation in 1996. **Dress Code:** Smart casual

Thursday, 19 June 2025 - Buffet Dinner at the Orangery of Charlottenburg Palace (19.30 - 22.30)

The **Orangery of Charlottenburg Palace** welcomes you in royal splendour. Built between 1709 and 1712 as an elongated one-storied Baroque building, it primarily served to protect the extensive orange, bitter orange and lemon tree collection of the Hohenzollern family during the winter months. In the summer the Orangery was used as a prestigious venue for balls, receptions and wedding celebrations. After being heavily damaged during World War II, the renovation of the exterior was completed in 1962.

Friday, 20 June 2025 - Gala Dinner at Tempelhof Airport (19.30 - 03.00)

Tempelhof its current form was built between 1936 and 1941 according to the plans of Ernst Sagebiel. The biggest monument of Europe, which stands for monumental self-staging of the Nazis, has become a symbol of freedom because of the airlift of 1948/49. The last plane landed here in 2008, in 2010 the area became public greenspace. The former runway is now

mobbed with wind-carters and joggers, while the airport's interior with its retro check-in desks, analogue clocks and neon signs is a flashback to the golden age of air travel.

HALF DAY PROGRAMME

Berlin Guided Tour (Walking & bus tour) - approx. 5 hours

The tour combines bus comfort with a guided walk to provide you with a comprehensive experience of Berlin, ensuring you don't miss any of its highlights.

The ride takes you past the Reichstag Building, Museum Island, Kurfürstendamm and Charlottenburg Palace. You will have the opportunity to get off the bus to discover the Brandenburg Gate on Pariser Platz, Checkpoint Charlie and the Holocaust Memorial, as well as to stroll through Gendarmenmarkt just before lunch. Expert guides will lead you through the top attractions of the German capital, sharing fascinating insights into its history and culture.

FULL DAY PROGRAMME

Berlin Highlights and Street Art (Walking & bus tour) - approx. 8 hours

The morning will be dedicated to Berlin's top sights including the Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag, Holocaust Memorial, Checkpoint Charlie, Museum Island and Gendarmenmarkt.

After lunch you will dive in the world of urban art. People have been spraying and tagging in Berlin since the 70s, famous artists have left their mark on its streets. You will discover the district Kreuzberg around Wranglkiez and have a walk over the Oberbaum Bridge to East Side Gallery, the longest open-air gallery in the world. Here, along the river Spree, 118 artists from 21 countries began painting immediately after the fall of the Berlin Wall on 9 November 1989 and commented on the political changes of 1989/90. Hear stories that make the East Side Gallery a special place in Berlin, fates that happened at this historic piece of the Wall and anecdotes from the artists.
